

Inclement Weather Policy

In the event of inclement weather, New Frontiers Public Schools (NFPS) will choose from two options:

- Close school for the day
- Delay the opening of school

Safety is our main concern in deciding whether school opens during inclement weather. It is impossible to know the road conditions in all areas of San Antonio, and we urge you to use your own judgment in deciding whether or not your child should go to school if driving seems unsafe.

A closed school day or early dismissal applies to all students, teachers and employees, including afterschool care, clubs, and/or evening programs. If we decide to close school and/or delay the opening, we will alert the below television stations and notify social media to broadcast our decision as soon as possible. In addition, we will post an emergency bulletin on the front page of the website www.newfrontierspublicschools.org. NFPS will contact the primary and secondary contact numbers listed in the student records. In the event that NFPS is not mentioned by name, please listen to SAISD (San Antonio Independent School District) closings, as NFPS will mirror their closings and early dismissals during inclement weather as NFPS shares SAISD school boundaries.

Make-up days and additional instructional minutes for emergency closings have been built into school calendar for a fixed graduation date and a more stable end-of-school year date.
